

Call for Artists – Black & White,

February 8 - 26, 2012

This show is black and white and all shades in between! Drawings, sketches, charcoal, photography, paintings, fabric art, sculpture and glass art. Any medium, 2- or 3-dimensions is acceptable. Each Artist is limited to 4 entries less than 36" in any dimension, or contact us to discuss possibilities if you have a special request or unique requirements. This Fine Art Show will be juried

by way of digital images. Please do not submit work that has previously been displayed at the Coast Collective show. No work needs to be delivered to the Gallery prior to acceptance and no adjudication fees apply. Artwork on display in the Coast Collective Gift Shop may not be removed to be entered in Coast Collective Gallery Shows. All submitted work must be original, not copied from any other artist – which includes not using photographs taken by other people as source material.

Applications for this show can be submitted using the on-line form linked to the Art Gallery page of our website: www.coastcollective.ca (preferred), or copies of the application form can be downloaded from there and, accompanied by images of your work, e-mailed, mailed or delivered. A \$5 per piece processing fee will be due for application not handled using electronic images. If you have trouble using the on-line application form, please send an e-mail to galleries@coastcollective.ca explaining your problem and we'll help. There are some tips available at the bottom of the Gallery page on our website. Application forms and images must be received **no later than January 19, 2012**. Artists will be notified by January 26 about what works have been accepted. Further instructions about the delivery of accepted works will be provided at that time. A \$12 hanging fee per accepted piece will be charged upon delivery of artwork, and a 30% Commission will be retained by the Gallery for each piece sold. If, as a direct result of showing work at the Coast Collective the work sells after the show, the gallery would appreciate a 10% finder's fee. Pick up of artwork

The artist is responsible for picking up his/her artwork at the specified time at the end of each show. A \$5 per day fee will be due from the artist for each piece not picked up on time unless arrangements are made PRIOR to the pick-up date.

Artwork not picked up

Artwork not collected before the storage fees exceed the price for the piece specified by the artist or within 6 months of the end of the show, whichever comes first, will become the property of the Coast Collective.
