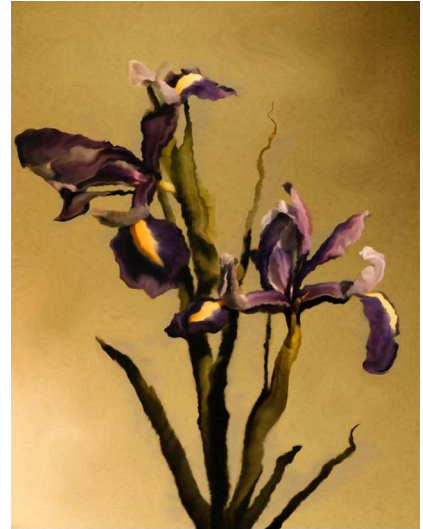


**Call for Art - Salon des Refusés-May 30 – June 17, 2012**  
**Coast Collective Gallery**

In the fine tradition of 19th century Paris, Coast Collective will mount our Third Annual show of **works rejected by other major juried shows** in the area. All work entered into this show must have been **REJECTED** at another major art show. Please indicate in the “Notes” section of the application form the show that rejected each piece. Each Artist is limited to 3 entries less than 24” x 36”, or contact us to discuss possibilities if you have a larger piece. This Fine Art Show will be juried by way of digital images. No work needs to be delivered to the Gallery prior to acceptance and no adjudication fees apply. All submitted work must be original, not copied from any other artist – which includes **not** working from photographs taken by other people. Artwork on display in the Coast Collective Gift Shop may not be removed to be entered in Coast Collective Gallery Shows.



Applications can be submitted using the on-line form linked to the Art Gallery page of our website: [www.coastcollective.ca](http://www.coastcollective.ca) (preferred), or copies of the application form can be downloaded from there and, accompanied by images of your work, e-mailed, mailed or delivered. Application forms and images **must be received no later than May 10, 2012**. Artists will be notified by May 17, 2012 about what works have been accepted. Further instructions about the delivery of accepted works will be provided at that time. A \$12 hanging fee per accepted piece will be charged upon delivery of artwork, and a 30% Commission will be retained by the Gallery for each piece sold. If, as a direct result of showing work at the Coast Collective the work sells after the show, the gallery would appreciate a 10% finder’s fee. **Security and Liability**

**Pick up of artwork**

The artist is responsible for picking up his/her artwork at the specified time at the end of each show. A \$5 per day fee will be due from the artist for each piece not picked up on time unless arrangements are made PRIOR to the pick-up date.

**Artwork not picked** up Artwork not collected before the storage fees exceed the price for the piece specified by the artist or within 6 months of the end of the show, whichever comes first, will become the property of the Coast Collective.
