

## **Watercolour Workshop by Sandhu Singh**

### **What am I going to teach in my workshop?**

**Small lecture on drawing, composition, fundamentals of water-colour. I will do few demos where students can ask me questions. After each demo students will repeat the exercise and I will come around and answer their questions**

**I WILL NOT TALK ABOUT PARTICULAR COLORS, COLOR WHEELS AND I DO NOT DO FLOWERS OR PORTRAITS**

**I WILL BRING FEW PHOTOS AND I will pick demos from them**

### **Material list:**

DO NOT SPEND TOO MUCH \$ ON SUPPLIES. I will work it around peoples supplies..... I hate wasting money.

-I use an easel and if you are comfortable with easel then bring one. I would imagine most folks have one.

-Rough 140 LB paper – ONLY a few sheets please. Arches or Saunders brand will do, but avoid buying those blocks of 140 LB

-Tubes of paint. I use, Ultramarine blue, cerulean blue, violet, cadmium red, cadmium yellow, Burnt Sienna, raw sienna, Raw amber, brunt amber, some kind of plum red, cadmium orange . I do not own tube of green paint....hate green paint; however, people can bring whatever green tube they have.

**PLEASE DO SPRAY SOME WATER ON YOUR DRIED UP PAINTS IF THEY ARE ALREADY OUT OF THE TUBE ON A TRAY THE NIGHT BEFORE THE WORKSHOP SO THAT THEY ARE MOIST AND READY TO GO!**

Brushes: I ask that people bring their favourite ones, the ones they feel confident and comfortable with. I only use round brushes mostly size 8 and over. I would request/ask students to invest in Mop brush, at least medium size but not large and a rigger.

-What name brand paints: avoid dollar store brand for sure. Local art stores sell many different thing. If people have Windsor & Newton, go with those. Holbein water-colours are good as well. Plus Daniel Smith is okay as well. Do not buy Van Gogh.

-A pencil, eraser, bucket of water, towel paper.

Workshops are about learning new things, shedding old habits and being open minded to embracing new things. So just be willing to look at this workshop as an opportunity to indulge in a fun creativity.
