

## Supplies List

1. Two or three magazines or books with strong, good quality, high contrast photos (will not be torn or cut out)
2. An 8 ½ x11" printout or photocopy of one of your paintings (or small original painting)
3. Several of your photos that you think show strong compositions.
4. Soft pencil, pencil crayons, or felt pens and sketching paper for quick sketches.
5. View finder (2 L-shaped pieces of card stock in White, Grey or Black).
6. 3 or 4 Canvases, or canvas board or illustration board or Water color paper (16" x 20" or larger).
7. Painter's green tape (FROG tape is best, available at hardware stores in paint dept.).
8. Acrylic or watercolor paints (but acrylic paints are most adaptable). You may use cheap liquid acrylics bought at Dollar Store.
9. Brushes, several sizes including a 1" household brush preferably with a chisel point.
10. Plastic table covers and/or newspapers.
11. Water container and spray bottle for water.
12. Digital camera.
13. An old unsuccessful painting you wish to rework.
